L. I. F. E. DAILY DEVOTIONAL BIBLE READING GUIDE

- **Light:** Begin reading until you have a "light-bulb" moment from the Holy Spirit (something grabs you from the text).
- **Intercession:** Pray over the verse or verses for personal revelation, and begin to intercede for the needs and the individuals God places on your heart.
- **Forgiveness:** Ask the Lord for His forgiveness and cleansing. Praise and Thank Him for His Grace (I John 1:8-9)!
- Engagement: Write (journal) your personal thoughts and prayers:
 - **1.** Copy the verse(s) from your "light-bulb" moment, into your journal.
 - **2.** Under the verses, write down your observations, thoughts, and prayers.
 - 3. Write down your plan of action to "engage", though active obedience, the things the Lord has shown you.

Daily Reading Plan:

- Experienced Readers: Read 3 chapters in the Old Testament and 1 chapter in the New Testament. (You can complete the Bible in a year).
- ♦ New Readers: Read 2-3 chapters in the New Testament. Read through the New Testament two times, then begin experienced reading plan.
- Enjoy Yourself: Don't worry if you miss a day. Just pick up the next day where you left off!
