How To Use This Study Guide

This self-guided study, "Jesus, the Trinity, and Me," was created as a tool to help Parents and Kid's Ministry Leaders introduce younger children to the Biblical Teaching of the Trinity. The understanding of who God is, is foundational to an understanding of the Person and Work of the Holy Spirit. This study is a preparation for the companion study, "Jesus, the Holy Spirit, and Me."

Like "Jesus, Baptism, and Me," this is meant to be an <u>interactive study</u> with your child (student). You will gain the most from it together - by allowing your child (student) to:

- **FIND** the Bible verse referenced. (You can also help them learn the Books of the Bible in the process.)
- **READ** the Bible verse out loud. (You can help them with any words they do not know, but assist them in reading the verses out loud themselves.)
- ANSWER the questions themselves. (You can assist them by <u>asking key questions</u> that will guide them in their discovery, but it is important that they discover the answers themselves.)
- PACE the study according to your child's (student's) personal level of interest and understanding. In a classroom setting this will take on a different dynamic. However, the goal is not to rush the child to complete the booklet, but to lead them to an understanding that there is one God, eternally existent in three persons, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
- **ENJOY** the study with your child (student). This discovery process is meant to be both <u>life-changing and fun</u>. (Use creativity in finding examples that can further illustrate the truths.)
- CELEBRATE the answers and discovery of your child (student). When he or she gets an
 answer correct <u>rejoice</u>! Let your child know that both you and the Lord are proud of
 them!

The goal of this study is to affirm what the Scriptures proclaim about God, explore how this relates to our lives, and to prepare your child (student) for a deeper understanding of the **Person and Work of the Holy Spirit.** The follow up material to this study is **"Jesus, the Holy Spirit, and Me."**


Principles for Young Believers

I. What does the Bible have to say about God?

- A. The Bible is a wonderful book that teaches us all about God. When we read the Bible we learn that there are many different so-called "gods" that some people worship. However, for us there is only ONE "True God"! This One and Only "True God" created the world along with all of the stars and galaxies in the sky. This One "True God" also created both you and me! Read the following verses and write down what you discover about what the Bible says about God.
 - 1. I Corinthians 8:5-6: Yet, for us there is God.
 - 2. Ephesians 4:4-6: There is only one Father who is ______.
 - 3. <u>John 1:1-4</u>: Jesus, who is also called the Word, is _____.

- B. Do you remember when you were baptized in water after you received Jesus Christ as your personal Savior and Lord, and finished your study in "Jesus, Baptism, and Me?" Perhaps you heard your pastor say, "I baptize you in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit"? Maybe you didn't think anything about that when you were baptized. Yet, have you ever wondered how can there be only "One God" when the Bible tells us that the Father is God, Jesus is God, and the Holy Spirit is God?

- I. What does the Bible have to say about God? Continued
 - B. How can there be only "One God"? Continued
 - 2. Have you ever heard the word "Trinity" before? This is a word that is not found in the Bible, but it is a word that has been used for hundreds and hundreds of years to explain what we just discovered in the Bible. Let's take a closer look!
 - a. Read Deuteronomy 6:4: "Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is _____!" (Fill in the blank)
 - b. Also remember, in the verses we read on the previous page, we discovered that the Father, Jesus, and the Holy Spirit are ALL called ______. (Fill in the blank)
 - c. The word <u>Trinity</u> simply means "<u>three in one.</u>" It is a word we use to describe this wonderful discovery. The **One** "True God" we serve exists in three distinct and different persons!
 - d. The Trinity, the One "True God" is:
 - The **Father** our **Creator**,
 - The Son (Jesus Christ) our <u>Savior</u>, and
 - The **Holy Spirit** our <u>Guide</u> and constant companion.
 - e. It is **through the <u>Holy Spirit</u>** that we learn about the **Father** and **Jesus**. It is through the <u>Holy Spirit</u> that we can understand the <u>Bible</u> and the wonderful discoveries we can find each day as we read it!
 - 3. When we read the Bible, and when we place our faith in Jesus Christ, the <u>Trinity</u> really isn't so hard to understand. In fact, as we think more about this discovery, we learn some very helpful things about life – and about ourselves!



- I. What does the Bible have to say about God? Continued
 - C. Did you know that you can discover the **principle of the <u>Trinity</u>** in many different areas of our everyday life?
 - 1. Have you ever looked at a **Three Leaf Clover**? A long time ago a man by the name of St. Patrick used this example to explain the **Trinity**. While there are three different leaves, there is only one clover. Others have used an **Apple** to explain this wonderful discovery. An apple has a skin, the fruit, and seeds in the middle, yet there is only one apple. Look at the pictures below.




- 2. But do you know what is the greatest example of this wonderful discovery? It is **YOU** and **ME!** The Bible teaches us that we were created in **God's image**. Read the verses below!
 - a. Genesis 1:26-27: "Then God said, 'Let <u>Us</u> (the Father, Jesus, and the Holy Spirit) make man in <u>Our image</u>, according to <u>Our likeness</u>....' So <u>God</u> created man <u>in His own image</u>; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them."
 - b. Wow! We were created just like God! Do you know what that means? It means that we, too, are like the clover and like the apple. Did you know that you and I are made up of <u>three distinct parts</u> yet we, too, are one!

- I. What does the Bible have to say about God? Continued
 - D. We were created **like God** <u>in His image</u>! We are not "gods," but when we believe in Jesus Christ we become the Children of God! As his children we have something that wonderfully reflects the very nature of God in our lives. We have THREE wonderful parts that make up who we are.
 - E. Read the following verses and discover what these are! (Hint: Look at the picture of the apple below!)

- 2. <u>Hebrews 4:12</u>: "God's word is living and active. It is sharper than any two-edged sword and cuts as deep as the place where **soul** and **spirit** meet, the place where **joints and marrow** meet. God's word judges a person's thoughts and intentions" (GW).
 - a. The **spirit** is our **heart**.
 - b. The **soul** is our **mind**.
 - c. The **joints and marrow** make up our **body**.
- 3. Like the apple and the three leaf clover, **but most importantly like God** we have **three parts to our life!**
- 4. All three parts are very important to God, and all three parts make up the one person we call **YOU and ME!**

- II. The Trinity, the Father, Son, and Holy Sprit is at work in my life.
 - A. God the **Father**, God the **Son**, and God the **Holy Spirit** each help us in our **total life body**, **soul**, **and spirit!**
 - 1. **ETERNAL Life:** The **FATHER** sent **Jesus** so that we could have **eternal life** by believing in Him!
 - READ John 3:16
 - 2. <u>ABUNDANT Life</u>: JESUS gives us salvation (through his death and resurrection) so that we can be forgiven, become God's children, and live an abundant life!
 - READ John 1:12-13 & John 10:10
 - 3. **EMPOWERED Life:** The **HOLY SPIRIT** gives us **Power** so that we can obey the Father, walk and live like Jesus, and become witnesses of God's love to those who have never met Jesus as their personal Savior and Lord!
 - READ Acts 1:8
 - B. If we are going to live like **God's Children**, if we are going to daily follow and obey Jesus, and if we are going to tell others about how they can meet Jesus as their personal Savior and Lord **then we need POWER!**
 - C. And to receive **God's Power** we need the **HOLY SPIRIT!**

- B. <u>BIG NEWS!</u> Since the **Holy Spirit** does not have a body, and since **He is God**, He can be **everywhere** and with **everyone** at the same time! (Read Luke 24:39; John 14:15-16.)
- C. <u>BIG NEWS!</u> When you received Jesus Christ as your personal Savior and Lord, the Holy Spirit came to live <u>IN</u> your heart!
 (Read the following and fill in the blanks.)
 - 1. John 14:16-17: "...He dwells with you, and will be _____ you."

 - 3. <u>Galatians 4:6</u>: "...God has sent forth the Spirit of His son into your ."

- D. BIG NEWS! Help is on the way!
 - 1. When you followed Jesus Christ in water baptism, you made a public promise to everyone (including God) that you were going to live a new life of obedience as you daily followed Jesus.
 - 2. The **Holy Spirit**, who now lives **IN** your heart, also wants to give you "**Special Power**" (ability) so that you can do what you promised to live and be like Jesus!
- E. <u>BIG NEWS!</u> This gift of "Special Power" (ability) comes when the Holy Spirit is allowed to live both <u>in you</u> and <u>through you</u>. The Bible calls this the "Baptism of the Holy Spirit"!
- F. <u>BIG NEWS</u>! WE CAN ALL BE <u>BAPTIZED IN THE HOLY SPIRIT!</u>

A. Did you know that, just like you, Jesus was <u>baptized in water</u>, and He was also <u>baptized in the Holy Spirit</u> (to receive God's "Special Power" before He began His ministry).

 - B. Do you remember what the word "baptize" means?
 - 1. It means to be dipped, immersed, fully covered, and united.
 - 2. This is why you were <u>dipped under the water</u> when you followed Jesus in water baptism.
 - 3. Then, just like you <u>rose up out of the water</u>, now the Holy Spirit wants to flow up out of your life in power!
 - Jesus called this wonderful gift of the Holy Spirit in our lives
 _____ water. (Read John 7:38 for the answer!)
 - 5. In water baptism you entered into physical water. When you are Baptized in the Holy Spirit you receive the overflowing power of "living water" (which is the ______). (Read John

 - C. This "Special Power" from God is **FREE** but just like the **FREE**Gift of Salvation, You Must Ask For It!
 - 1. <u>Luke 11:9, 13</u>: "So I say to you, ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you...If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him!" (NKJV)
